## Troop Gear List

Your campsite will be your home away from home. Each troop or patrol will need to set up its area within the conservation plan of the Camp. Please refer to the following lists to ensure you are well prepared.

Undergarments (min. 6 pair)

## CAMPING GEAR

Sleeping Pad (Optional: Cots are  
metal grate with springs)

## TOILETRIES

Toothpaste and Toothbrush\*  
Soap and Shampoo\*  
Hand Sanitizer  
Medications  
Bath Towels/Washcloth  
Emergency Toilet Paper  
Deodorant\*  
Shaving Gear  
First Aid Kit -All troops should have.  
Comb/Small Mirror  
Sunscreen\* - **APPLY FREQUENTLY!**  
Chap-stick with SPF\*
